3	<ul> <li>Makes a prediction or draws a conclusion about the text</li> <li>May include details that are not explicitly stated</li> <li>May include details, predictions, or conclusions that are inaccurate or unsubstantiated based on text information</li> </ul>
2	<ul> <li>Attempts to make a prediction or draw a conclusion about the text</li> <li>Includes some inaccuracies such as details, conclusions, or predictions that are inaccurate or unsubstantiated based on text information</li> </ul>
1	<ul> <li>No evidence of inference (making a prediction, interpreting information or drawing a conclusion) about the text</li> <li>Conveys a minimum amount of information about the text</li> <li>May include information that is off topic</li> </ul>
